Franklin Township Fire Levy Vote FOR Issue 18

On the November 3, 20202 general election voters of the unincorporated areas within Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio will be able to support their fire and EMS department by passing Issue 18.

Voting FOR Issue 18 replaces the current timed 5.89 mills fire levy with a new timed 5.89 mills levy for five years.

Voting FOR Issue 18 allows our two professional, union fire stations to continue offering fire and EMS services for both the township and mutual aid runs into the surrounding areas.

Voting FOR Issue 18 does not add any new tax millage and applies the same millage to the recent valuations from the Franklin County Auditor.

Our two fire stations, fire engines, ambulances, and lifesaving services are dependent on the passage of this levy. This levy was placed on the ballot by a unanimous vote of all three Township Trustees after the failure of our spring levy.

Franklin Township has failed five levies and passed one in the last 5 years. The campaign will rely on direct mail, phone calls, text messages, and digital ads to communicate with voters.
